Novi Robotics *FIRST* Tech Challenge 2017 Nbot Program and Equipment Rental Agreement

FTC Team 1234 agrees to:

- Complete a 2018 Nbot Program and Equipment Rental Agreement;
- Register for the 2018 FTC season.

OR, if NOT continuing for the 2018 FTC season, FTC Team 1234 agrees to:

- Replace any modified, broken, damaged or lost items from their Kit of Parts;
- Return the Kit of Parts in its original condition which will include disassembling their Robot;
- Return TIMs team management to the Nbot mentor;

Nbot through FRC Team 503 agrees to provide:

- Registration for FTC Team 1234 through TIMs paying the \$275 team registration fee;
- FTC Team 1234 with a complete Kit of Parts;
- Frog Force student mentorship weekly;
- Waived admission to any Frog Force Fall FTC workshops or scrimmages;
- An ongoing relationship with NEF for corporate sponsorships;
- Eligibility for State MDE FTC grants;
- Eligibility for Frog Force 503 advancement grants.
